Background

- COPI7 Durban
 - The SA Cleantech competition in 2011 had great success
 - Challenges identified:
 - Regulatory environment and institutional capacity
 - Limited access to finance
 - Shortage of entrepreneurial skills
 - Limited R&D support
 - Lack of public awareness
- The programme has been running for 2 years
 - Working with emerging cleantech startups
 - In support of governments efforts to support a transition to a Green Economy
 - In SA 180 applications received since inception with 52 enterprises progressing through the programme








