# Standardisation and consistency is key

---

## Based on our experience we know:

- ▶ Experts and practitioners worldwide use different terminology in different languages to describe the same things → connection and understanding is often lost
- ▶ Need to **increase consistency and connections** to see the full picture of clean energy technology and policy
- ▶ The answer is **standardized tagging across regions and languages**
- ▶ This is particularly important for technical and policy-relevant content such as RE
