Sustainable Energy for All Initiative

1.2 billion people worldwide are without access to electricity, and a billion more have only intermittent access. **2.8 billion** people lack access to clean cooking solutions.

In response, UN Secretary-General Ban Ki-moon launched a new initiative in 2011 by the same name (SE4ALL), calling on governments, businesses, and civil society to make commitments to action to accomplish **three objectives** by 2030:







The UN General Assembly Member States have unanimously declared 2014-2024 as the **Decade of Sustainable Energy for All.**

Practitioner Network & PAYG solutions

- The International Energy Agency estimates that micro-grid & decentralized energy solutions will be the pathway to electricity access for roughly **60 percent** of the people who now lack it.
- In our 2014 survey, **only 1/3 respondents** reported using a financing scheme such as PAYG. Many are still accepting one-time cash payments.
- This interactive showcase of member organizations' approaches to PAYG offers an opportunity for practitioners to learn about their collective best practices as they discuss & contrast specific geographic contexts, and share their respective challenges and successes.
